Small shipment conference names annual carrier award winners

The National Small Shipments Traffic Conference (NASSTRAC) recently announced recipients of its 2009 Carrier of the Year awards.

The award program recognizes transportation providers' efforts in six areas: customer service, operational excellence, pricing, business relationship, leadership and technology.
